We provide a balanced, intellectually challenging programme which fosters in students the skills, knowledge and attitudes that enable them to be successful in school and in life.

We value the diversity of cultures within our school and our links to the local and global community. We recognise and accept our responsibility to promote intercultural understanding and to contribute to a sustainable, peaceful world.

THE SCHOOL

ISA is a private international school approved by the Bavarian Ministry of Education. Established in 2005, the International School of Augsburg has grown from 60 students to over 300. The school provides an international education in an English language learning environment for students from kindergarten to grade 12. ISA serves the local and international communities of the Augsburg, Donauwörth, Landsberg and the greater Munich area.

FACULTY & FACILITIES

ISA has an experienced, committed and caring faculty, with 36 teachers from around the world. Many hold advanced degrees in their subject areas. ISA promotes the ongoing professional growth and development of its teachers.

The school's facilities include classrooms, purpose built science labs, music rooms, art room, computer lab, school media centre and library, a cafeteria and full sports facilities for the athletics programme.

LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

Learning at ISA continues beyond the classroom. Sports@ISA, Model United Nations, student led CAS initiatives, LAP mentors and Student Publications give students opportunities to develop their "unique potential" and to build their leadership, collaborative and communication skills. Class trips to Spain, London and Iceland expose students to other cultures and natural environments. Work experience placements in grades 9 and 10 help students to imagine their future. The Immersion Programme to Zambia helps students to grow into more internationally-minded "confident, caring citizens of the world."

THE ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

The grade 9 & 10 curriculum is guided by the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) and is supplemented by internally developed subject curriculum. The grade 11 & 12 curriculum follows the IB Diploma Programme. The ISA high school diploma is also available to students.

THE IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme is a rigorous, pre-university curriculum. It aims to provide students a balanced two-year course of study. Students must successfully complete six externally examined courses, three at Higher Level and three at Standard Level. Additionally, students must complete the requirements of the Diploma Core: Extended Essay, Theory of Knowledge and Creativity, Activity and Service.
